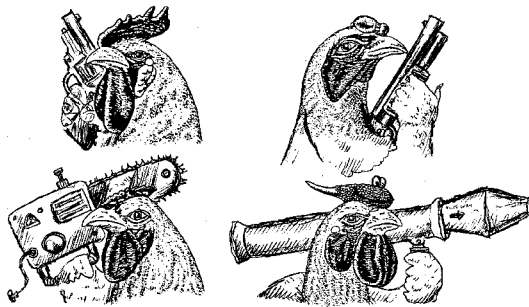


THE VOICE OF THE GODS
